BOOSTING SUPPORT FOR MULTICULTURAL MEDIA

This support will ensure multicultural communities see and hear important health, safety and emergency messages, while giving multicultural media outlets the revenue certainty they need to continue serving their communities.

A re-elected Labor Government will also provide \$1.5 million for a dedicated multicultural media grants program.

The grants will support multicultural media outlets with the rising cost of printing, helping them to invest in new equipment and employ more staff.

Labor has a strong record of supporting multicultural media outlets. Throughout the pandemic we invested an unprecedented \$2.9 million to support of multicultural media in our state – ensuring all Victorians were getting the vital health information they needed.
